### **PROCEDURE TO REQUEST DOCK SPACE FOR A GUEST BOAT**

From the Rules and Regulations of The Island Club Association: II (5) Guests' boats may be accommodated in vacant spaces, including the assigned spaces from which assignees are temporarily absent, with the approval of the Board of Directors for periods of time not in excess of seventy-two (72) hours, which the accommodations may be renewed. Nothing herein shall obligate the Board of Directors to renew guest accommodations and renewal may be refused without cause.

#### THE PROCEDURE IS:

1. This Procedure applies to ANY and ALL Guest boat dockage.
2. While every effort will be made to respond quickly, it may take a few days for a response, so plan ahead.
3. The Requestor must contact any member of the Board of Directors in writing or by email. (Email contact information can be found in the Contact List or the links on the Association Info page on the website) It is recommended that you contact all the members of the Board in case any one of them is not available.
4. You must supply the following information in your request:
  - a. The make and complete model of the Guest boat.
  - b. The owner's name and immediate contact information (Email, Cell Phone, etc.).
  - c. A copy of the Insurance Policy for the Guest boat showing liability coverage.
  - d. The requested date and time of arrival of the Guest boat (remember the initial approval is limited to 72 hours).
5. Only an Owner or Approved Renter currently residing at the Island Club can request Guest space.
6. If approved a signed Guest Boat Approval form will be supplied to the requestor. The Board can refuse approval without cause as per the Rules and Regulations.
7. The signed Guest Boat Approval form must be displayed on the guest boat in a place where it is completely visible from the docks.
8. The Board of Directors may assign a specific slip for the guest boat.
9. The Requestor will be held responsible for the safety of the Guest vessel and the conduct of Guests.
  - a. There will be no sleeping aboard
  - b. No loud music
  - c. No working on the guest boat
  - d. No boat can be longer than 43 feet (LOA).
  - e. Boats must dock bow to the seawall in order to avoid damage from prop wash.
  - f. All Current Island Club Association Rules & Regulations must be followed by Guests.

Please remember maintaining the safety and tranquility of the common dock and grounds is in the interest of all the residents of The Island Club Association.
